2022 MISSIONS PROJECTS UPDATE

We are a church marked by celebration and we celebrate all that God has done in many lives this year around the world! We are so thankful for the generosity of First Assembly as we have been able to stay on mission locally and globally. We have so much to celebrate!



WE SAID, WE DID

GERMANY DAS KANADA HAUS RENOVATION PROJECT

In 2013, First Assembly purchased a building in Germany with the goal of reaching people for Christ and training church planters. In 2015 our Governing Council was led by God to donate the property to the PAOC International office.

The building was used to establish Das Kanada Haus. Led by Markus and Liz Brandt, it has become a mission base for shortterm mission teams, global workers in Eurasia and national churches in Germany as well as a support ministry, to encourage church planting and revitalization of small congregations without pastoral leadership, especially in East Germany.

In order to serve as the Eurasia base of the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada, the building required some renovations. They are expecting to host larger church groups, including a team of 50+ students from Summit Pacific, B.C. which will minister in Europe and the former East Germany. With the help of First Assembly, renovations are under way with the removing of walls to make a larger multi-purpose room to seat 70+ people and all the teams they plan to host in the coming years. The goal is to bring the house up to a higher standard and to make the house ready for all that God has planned.





HONDURAS INCA LINK HONDURAS - LA SIERRA, HONDURAS

Inca Link International is focused on reaching the 300 million youth in Latin America with Christ's irresistible love. With the help of First Assembly Church, Inca Link was able to build a new classroom building and furnish it for the kids to actually sit at tables and do work. They have built a new fence around the classroom as the old one had fallen down and there was barbed wire everywhere. This has made the grounds much safer for the children in the area. Last but not least, Inca Link has built new washrooms on the site.

All of these facilities are amazing and provide much needed resources in this area, but they actually signify something much deeper; a love and care for the families and children in this region, to know that they are not alone in their struggles and that they are seen. God is faithful!



NIGERIA: JINKAI INITIATIVE

Jinkai is a not-for-profit organization that works with families who have been adversely impacted by the ethno-religious clashes in Northern and North Central Nigeria. In the last year, with support from First Assembly Church and other partners, Jinkai has been able to serve as the hands and feet of the Lord. Some examples of their recent projects are:

- Scholarships Jinkai provided scholarships to two high school students from among the internally displaced persons who could not afford school fees.
- Medical bills, food and clothing Jinkai carried outreaches to provide food, medical bills, and clothing for people in need.
- Home rebuild Jinkai will supervise the rebuild and provide the compressed earth bricks to a community of about 20 homes in need of rebuilding.
- Jinkai provided ministry support to missionaries working in Southern Ethiopia, Northern Kenya and South Sudan.

Praise Report from Mark Kolo, Ministry lead: *"We give all the thanks to the LORD who provided* through partners for the purchase of 3 motorbikes for field ministry among the unreached in march. The new motorbike has already gone on its first mission outreach to several remote villages. Our missionary returned to Juba last week with testimonies of over 500 souls won through the JESUS Film shown in multiple villages. Follow up is being done by partner churches in the region."



SOUTH EAST ASIA PETER DOVE - MYANMAR FELLOWSHIP OF EVANGELICAL STUDENTS

The Myanmar Fellowship of Evangelical Students is a non-denominational ministry to university students in Myanmar. The ministry is led by Pastor Sawm, a former Assemblies of God Myanmar Pastor.

The 2022 partnership with First Assembly allowed them to purchase an apartment in Yangon, Myanmar that serves as a "third space"—a meeting space for university students who are connected to the Myanmar Fellowship of Evangelical Students. This is both a place of outreach and a centre for discipleship and training of university students in Yangon. This centre is located directly across the road from the Yangon University, Myanmar's most important university, but it also serves campuses all across the city. This ministry centre has become a home and a lighthouse of hope in a time of national crisis.

- Pray for peace and justice to reign in Myanmar.
- Pray for Myanmar believers to shine the light of Christ amid civil war.
- Pray for our Global Workers serving in 16 countries in Asia.
- Pray for university ministries reaching campuses in seven Asian countries.
- Pray for new Global Workers deployed into restricted access environments.

DAS KANADA HOUSE Brand new church planting projects with Paul and Amber in the city of Greifswald

East Germany is the most atheistic region in the world. Only 13% of East Germans say they believe in the existence of a God. A stunning 59% say they have never believed in God the highest statistic of its kind in the world. We envision a church where people who don't yet know God are welcomed and feel at home.

In the midst of all the preparations, we remember that everything we do is for Jesus, as he is really the one building and sustaining this church. It was His idea to create the global Church and it is His passion to see more people come to know Him through more churches being planted around the world.



PAOC MISSION GLOBAL TURKEY Earthquake Relief

On February 6, 2023, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck southeast Turkey near the Syrian border. A second 7.5 magnitude earthquake occurred soon after. Over 100 aftershocks have continued to cause untold damage. Many individuals and families have experienced terrible loss.

First Assembly sowed emergency funds to respond to this crisis in Turkey and Syria. This includes emergency food, clean water, blankets, tents, and clothes for many families. Help us pray for the thousands of lives impacted and that the light and hope of Jesus will shine in the midst of such unspeakable suffering.

The Psalmist David reminds us, "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit" (Ps. 34:18). May God comfort those who are suffering so deeply, and may they look to Him in their pain and sorrow.



ELEVIVA Kingdom Builders Donation for Ukraine refugee

Greg Swinamer is our global worker serving eastern Europe, an area impacted by the Russia-Ukraine war abruptly reshaping our world. With the door to travel in Russia and Ukraine effectively closed, the Lord directed the ministry to Poland, where for the past year he has been working on projects to assist Ukrainian refugees. In August 2022, Eleviva ministry launched a refugee center in Warsaw to give practical help to Ukrainians, such as food distribution to families who have no means of support. Since then, 3000 Ukrainian refugees have found a warm, safe place at the LIFE Center. In addition to food, refugees receive Polish and/or English language training, counselling, and free hair cuts. They meet new friends over coffee at the LIFE Cafe, there are activities for children in the LIFE Kids club and facilities for youth. The LIFE Center is a place where they can experience God's love and receive care in the midst of this difficult season.

MALI, WEST AFRICA MARKO AND PAULINE

Facilitating translation of a panoramic Bible in two Bozo languages, while Pauline's role is to ensure that all translated Scripture is made accessible to the Bozo-speaking peoples in every possible way. This includes radio programs, Bible storying and most recently, the dubbing of the "JESUS" film. They were evacuated to Burkina Faso in 2012 due to unrest in Mali, working from a distance for the next five years. Back in Mali since 2017, they are both fully involved in promoting the Bozo Scriptures and are excited to see God using His Word in the lives of the Bozo people.





MEDICAL MINISTRY INTERNATIONAL VICKI AND MATT PENNEY

In the fall of 2022, First Assembly contributed towards purchasing medical supply kits in support of medical missions. Two members of our faith community, Vicki and Matt Penney, were part of the team that traveled to South America to provide spiritual and compassionate health care to patients who would otherwise not have the financial means to obtain medical care. One example of the lifeimpacting work this team did can be noticed in the story of a three-year old boy from Peru named Marcelo. Marcelo was born with cerebral palsy and his mom carried him everywhere, which became more difficult as he got older. With the help of the team on this trip, Marcelo received medical care and was fitted for a wheelchair.

INDIA - RESTRICTED ACCESS C AND S

C and S were born and raised in South India. They were burdened to impact and care for the people in Southeast Asia. C and S will be teaching and training national leaders. They work with several non-profit organizations and educational institutions providing programs which help communities envision and enact their future. They will also travel to different provinces to train and develop existing leaders through seminars and conferences. So that such leadership training programs empower local citizens to more effectively giving their time and talent for the betterment of their own family and community. Their vision to raise a new generation of fully committed leaders who would provide hope for the hopeless in their community.



RESURGENCE

Resurgence Initiatives exist to inspire the Body of Christ to arise together for the Kingdom of God. We have a strong God-inspired passion and belief that "Canada Will Be Saved." This call burns in our hearts as a ministry and leadership team. We stand in the belief that our nation can be saved in this generation.

Psalm 72:8, the founding verse of Canada, declares that He shall have dominion from "sea to sea and to the rivers to the end of the earth." This fuels our drive to be a nation-wide movement – to see a Resurgence across Canada!



PAOC MULTIPLY NETWORK

The Multiply Network exists to inspire, initiate, resource, and champion church multiplication in our PAOC family. We desire to come alongside Districts, Churches, Leaders and Catalysts to help take the guesswork out of church multiplication and work towards providing all Canadians with access points to the Gospel.

ESTONIA

Estonia has been focused on raising church leaders and we celebrate a new church plant. With our Global Worker, Rodney Corcoran's mentorship, Jaan and Geiu have planted a church called, "Rae Kogudus."

They started a home group in one of the families' apartments, discipling and mentoring people. Last summer, after prayer and worship they felt strongly that God was calling them to plant a church. With the Alpha ministry being the main strategy in reaching and engaging people with the Gospel, they continue to meet on Sunday afternoons for worship, prayer, communion, and fellowship!

The church and Bible School in Estonia responded during the Ukrainian/Russian war by registering their homes to receive refugees. The students were also involved in the effort to help families cross the Polish/Ukraine border.



SARA CURDIE PAOC GLOBAL WORKER ZOE NETWORK

Sara works with ZOE Network as the lead for ZOE Global Projects. ZOE Network exists to empower and activate women and men, through Biblical discipleship and the power of the Holy Spirit, to experience ZOE life and thrive in the mission of God.

In 2022, Sara put together a leadership team of Khmer women in Cambodia to build the first ever women's leadership conference. The conference took place in October and it was a great success! 150 women attend the conference. The feedback was very encouraging, with women excited to learn more! There are plans in place for another conference in 2023.

Please pray for Sara this Spring as she heads to Malawi to work alongside partners, Fountain Of Life, who provide trauma care for victims of sexual violence. She will be training another group of leaders to be facilitators of the Flourish Course, so that they can lead women through discovery who God made them to be and how valuable they are.

C&S — I LIVING GOD CHURCH INDIA

C & S pastor Living God Church in India. Their work includes sharing the Gospel, discipling believers, and creating leaders. They are excited about what God is doing among them as hundreds of lives are being reached with the gospel, some examples are:

- Their upcoming Kids Camp in May that will reach 1000+ needy kids in 3 campuses.
- Launched a new Youth Organization YTM (Youth Transformation Movement) that will be reaching hundreds of students in local schools through special events.
- The Arise & Build Leadership Training Centre they have had two fruitful batches of students that have come from all over their province to join a one year residential course that will train them to be leaders and church planters.

Please pray for:

- New campuses/church plants they currently have four campuses spread throughout the province. They need the favor, sustenance, and grace from the Lord to reach the people of Tamil Nadu.
- Their family being on the front lines is not easy as a family, we need the constant protection and peace of the Lord.



MARKO AND PAULINE

God is advancing His Kingdom through Bible translation for the Koso* fishing peoples and rice farmers along the Niger River. Twenty years ago, there were no known Jesus followers among these Muslim people groups. Now one Koso man has finished his training as a pastor and is church planting among his people. Another of our close partners is a keen evangelist who shares God's Word in his own language on the radio. Others are growing in faith.

With their and others' involvement, Scripture continues to be translated, recorded and distributed through radio programs, a Scripture app, film, websites and WhatsApp groups. Having just completed the book of Acts in February, we are preparing to return to W. Africa in the summer to continue the translation of Epistles. Thank you for partnering with us to open God's life-giving Word to people who have never had a chance to hear it before!

Pray that:

- Koso* people would interact deeply with the translated Scripture and be transformed as they come to know Jesus.
- Marko, Pauline and the team would work in harmony

and be protected as the translation moves ahead.

- The translators themselves would come to know Jesus as they handle God's Holy Scriptures.
- God would call more local believers to share the translated Scriptures and the gospel with the Koso.
- There would be positive conditions for evangelism and church growth in W. Africa.
- Marko and Pauline's children would grow in their relationship with Jesus as the family is physically separated.



RODNEY & KAJA CORCORAN ESTONIA, EASTERN EUROPE

This year one of the key goals of the Bible School has been to foster unity across the church. This is one of the reasons why the Bible school has worked in cooperation with the Russian speaking churches. One of our main programs for developing the church and its lay leaders is Deacons' school. This year we have worked with translators to be able to provide adequate training for those leaders in the Russian speaking churches. One of our thankful students is from Ukraine. He came with his family earlier last year when the war began. We are pleased to see him integrate into the Estonian church: to find community and have an opportunity to serve.

Currently we are working on our program for the 2023-2024 school year with a greater emphasis on practical ministry. We look forward to welcoming to students and having them participate in planting churches and developing community. It is an honour to be a part of expanding the Kingdom here in Estonia.

 Current students: In May they will be graduating.
 Please pray that as they leave the Bible school that they would transition well, especially those taking on new ministry responsibilities.

DARCY AND LEANNE

God is moving! Leanne and I serve in Asia and Canada working with leaders through our PAOC mission and through ZOE Network. We are seeing breakthrough in both areas of mission.

ZOE Network is currently completing French translation of leadership discipleship materials, beginning translation work in Spanish, and working on contextualizing material for Sub-Saharan Africa. Both women and men are going through our courses and we get to hear of real life transformation.

In Asia we have increasing opportunity to serve into leaders and churches. We are blessed by the trust extended to us as we teach on leadership and mission in schools and churches. Recently we trained 50 leaders on a Christcentred marriage and they will now train 1200 others. Wow.

We are grateful for your partnership with us. Moving forward means encountering obstacles and you have helped us to push past them. Thank you!

GREG & LYNNE SWINAMER EURASIA

The Swinamers serve with Next Level International Eurasia. They have worked in Europe for the past 18 years and Greg specifically works alongside pastors and church planters in the Russian-speaking regions of Eurasia. After years of assisting new churches in Ukraine and Russia, the Swinamers pivoted their ministry in March 2022 to helping Ukrainians displaced by the war. The Lord prompted Greg to go to Poland where he assisted the main Pentecostal Union in their refugee efforts. He brokered a partnership with Samaritans Purse Canada (SPC) and facilitated the distribution of US\$1.2 million over 8 months to assist churches that were hosting refugees.

Greg also partnered with Slovo Viary, a large Ukrainian church in Warsaw, that was helping thousands of refugees and those still in Ukraine. With SPC's support, they established two LIFE centres, where displaced Ukrainians receive practical help such as food and clothing distribution, Polish and English language training, counselling, job assistance, programs for children and youth, conversation/prayer over coffee, small group fellowship, and even free haircuts. They are receiving requests and looking to establish LIFE centres in other Polish cities.



Prayer points:

- Pray for the conflict in Ukraine to end, for peace to be restored and lives saved.
- Pray for great spiritual impact on Ukrainian refugees through the ministry of the LIFE Centres in Poland.
- Pray for large financial resources to be raised to launch new LIFE Centres and sustain existing ones.
- Pray for Lynne for increased health and strength in her fight against cancer.



He then began to hold open air services in the village and many community members started attending them and then opening house churches. When the security forces questioned him, he simply responded that after his building had been shut down, he was carrying on the work the only way that he could. In the end, God used the opposition they faced to reach many people that would have never entered a church building.



RESTRICTED ACCESS NORTH AFRICA

We support Global Workers who are living and working in a region of North Africa that is opposed to the Gospel. Our partners' mission is to make Spiritfilled disciples and plant multiplying fellowships of indigenous believers. They have many projects on the go and nothing compares to the joy of seeing the fruit coming from these projects. One of their college graduates shared a beautiful testimony of perseverance. He was working to plant a church in a small village for the past couple of years. In the Fall of 2021, the security services responded to a complaint and closed the church. He was disappointed but knowing that God had called him to plant this church, he began to pray and seek the Lord for a solution.



Prayer points:

- Ministry Pray for capacity for the projects they have on the go.
- Family Pray for their family, with their children attending university in Canada and school in Kenya.
- Rest They will be returning to Canada this summer to be reunited with family.
- Mission Pray for their training program's impact on the apprentices

MARK AND VAL HAZZARD LATIN AMERICA/CARIBBEAN

Mark and Val Hazzard pastored in Ontario for 38 years. They were then invited to serve as the PAOC Regional Missions Director for Latin America/ Caribbean (LAC) which they have done for the last 4 years. They serve approximately 40 missionaries in 16 countries.

A FEW HIGHLIGHTS OF OUR MINISTRY

Our work with the most vulnerable

Together with ERDO, 17 projects have been carried out in crisis response, community development and child development with over 1500 kids in the ChildCarePlus program over five sites vocational training schools in Guatemala, Jamaica, Honduras, and the DR, Theological training in the DR, Cuba, Uruguay and, Costa Rica rehab centers in Uruguay and Cuba over 500 AG pastors in Cuba receive some level of monthly support.

Our work with the Least Reached

- Encouraging national leaders to expand their missions.
- Working with the Caribbean Fellowship of Assemblies of God Executives.

One Celebration Point: the completion of the first five buildings of the Ministry Development Center in the Dominican Republic.

GLOBAL PROJECTS



This is why the leader of Guinea's national church the Reverend Bandjou Leno, along with Mission Global workers, Phil and Judy Bowler, are seeking to bring the gospel to Guinea while responding to the physical needs of Guinean children. They are currently constructing the Sonfonia Health and Training Centre, within the capital city of Conakry. The Centre will be a place to train upwards of 900 pastors and lay leaders to plant 1,000 churches throughout Guinea, over the next ten years. It will also provide a paediatric clinic with the goal to medically treat upwards of 30 children per day.



GUINEA SONFONIA HEALTH & TRAINING CENTRE

Guinea is one of the least reached countries in Africa. It has a population of 13.5 million inhabitants, but sadly, 11.9 million of those residents have never heard the gospel message. In addition to Guinea being largely unreached, the country struggles to provide necessary medical care, especially for children. Their infant mortality rate is over 20 times higher than here in Canada, and yet, these are all preventable infant deaths if diagnosed early on and treated accordingly.



First Assembly's support of the Sonfonia Health and Training Centre will have a lasting impact on the country of Guinea as a whole. Many lives will be saved both physically and spiritually, in addition to increasing the standard of education and training for Guinean professionals.

URUGUAY EMMANUEL REHABILITATION CENTRE

Ministry Focus: With a fresh vision and a new country call to Uruguay, the Cetrulos plan to engage in ministry which fulfills Mission Global's mandate of reaching the lost and caring for the poor and marginalized as well as spiritual and leadership training for people of influence. Their vision was to plant an orphanage and rehab centre for men seeking to overcome addiction.

This year, First Assembly has committed to sowing into Emmanuel Rehabilitation Centre ministry, a ministry they established in Uruguay, made possible through volunteer efforts of church members who physically and spiritually feed these wonderful people. In the centre, men receive support to build a strong faith foundation which will empower them to persevere and overcome any obstacle to restoration.



CAMBODIA GLOBAL STUDENT CENTRE

Ian and Tiffanie Rowley are PAOC/PAONL global workers in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. Ian oversees Global Student Center and a dorm that aims to reach university students. They engage students through various ministries and programs that are offered at their center. With housing for 100 students in the dorm and through genuine relationships with the university students off-site, many have come to faith. They are now connected in the discipleship aspect of Global and to the young adult church on site.





The current student centre is operating out of a rented building that no longer meets their space needs as their centre serves attracts more students than they are able to serve at the moment. First Assembly will be sowing into their key initiative "Project 130 – Global Student Centre", an ongoing project to build a larger and better equipped university student centre in the city of Phnom Penh.



FA MECHANICS

FA Benevolence Testimony: Mary's Story



LOCAL PROJECTS

DERICK'S YOUTH CENTRE

Derick's Youth Centre is integrally passionate about playing a role in paving the way for a future filled with immeasurable hope, unimaginable restoration and dreams actualized for young people in our city with a focus on underprivileged youth. We inherently believe that each student possesses God-given worth, deserves equal access, and supports to accomplish the call on their lives. Our program accomplishes this through connecting students to trauma informed volunteers who offer mentorship and guidance to the students and work to see each student grow in their character, in building healthy relationships with one another, clarifying their purpose and establishing a rooted identity.

Consistency and stability is vital in youth work to ensure that our students feel safe and cared for. Running our programs on a weekly basis creates one consistent rhythm for students to engage in, however, location and proximity often create a barrier for students to access our program. One way we have worked to minimize this barrier is through running our programs within the communities we are serving. This has proven to be effective in removing transportation as a barrier to accessing our program weekly.

We have also initiated running a monthly drop in at First Assembly to offer connection and resources to students that do not have a DYC program running in their immediate community. The challenge we now face is having the resources to multiply ourselves adequately and efficiently to the communities expressing need. This encompasses finding appropriate spaces to run our program, being able to provide nutritious meals to all the students that attend and providing specifically tailored solutions to the individual needs of each student and their families. Food insecurity is a consistently loud concern amongst the majority of our students' families. The other challenge we face is accessibility for our oncea-month drop-ins at the church, which offers connection for students who do not have a DYC program running in their immediate community yet. We are hope filled that we will be able to find a long-term solution that will remove accessibility as a deterrent for students to access our program.

EMMA HOUSE

Over the past year, Emma House has experienced a lot of growth and changes. We welcomed a new Executive Director, Michelle Narang, to the Emma House team in June 2022. Our team saw triumph and tragedy that proved beyond measure that the passion for what we are doing here is stronger than anything put in our way. We learn strength from those we serve. While the biggest risk to Emma House is the lack of core funding for our day-to-day, year-overyear operations - our biggest assets are those we serve each day and their stories of success and transformation. Emma House resonates with so many, which translates into the support we need to carry on; I'm confident that our community will ensure that this program continues to serve and impact for as many years as necessary. Emma House has been entrusted for 30 years with the most precious members of our community - mothers and babies - and we couldn't do this work without the support of our donors and ambassadors.

In 2022, Emma House provided programmed housing to 14 moms and 14 babies experiencing or at risk of homelessness. With a growing waitlist of 54 expecting mothers, there is a strong need in our community for services such as Emma House. Outside of programmed housing support, Emma House provided 74 moms and their children with life skills training, essential care items, referrals, and Christmas gifts through our annual Christmas Campaign.


WHY V100?


